For nearly 90 years, The Cradle has been highly regarded as one of the country's foremost adoption agencies. Over the years, we have placed more than 15,000 children into permanent, loving homes.

The Sayers Center is part of The Cradle's domestic adoption program. It is one of the only programs in the country that promotes adoption and adoption awareness specifically within the African American community. The goal of the Sayers Center is to find safe, loving, permanent homes for African American babies. The majority of babies placed through the Sayers Center are newborns.

Who Can Adopt

The Cradle welcomes prospective parents of all religious, racial and ethnic backgrounds, couples and singles. Prospective adoptive parents must be at least 25 years of age.

Many families who adopt through the Sayers program become parents within a year.

African American Adoption

- More than 35 percent of the adoptions at The Cradle are African American babies
- Only 15-20% of Cradle adoptive parents are African American
- There is a great need for more African American adoptive parents

Our Philosophy: Open Adoption

The Cradle embraces an open adoption philosophy for all domestic adoptions. This means that birth parents and adoptive families have the opportunity to get to know one another before and after placement, and to agree upon the level of any ongoing contact.


Affordable Adoption Fees

As a not-for-profit child welfare organization, The Cradle makes every attempt to make our fees as affordable as possible. Because of generous donations, the cost of an adoption through the Sayers Center is less than \$14,000 – just 35 percent of the actual expense. A variety of financial assistance programs are available, including the Federal Adoption Tax Credit.

The Cradle is the only agency in the country to maintain a 24-hour, fully staffed on-site nursery.
